So what really happens?

1.

Gather your choral collaboration and commit to enter 'Sing for Cransley! Ideally, choirs will be formed of at least 15 participants, but can be made up of friends, family, colleagues etc... so it's easy to pull together a team!

You'll be allocated a professional singing teacher who you will meet in October. You'll also need to decide on a fun and fabulous name for your choir - as well as kick-starting your fundraising efforts!

Rehearsals will begin in January and you can work closely with your teacher to rehearse as often as you'd like! There is plenty of flexibility as to when and where you practice to suit all schedules.

There'll be a dress rehearsal on Saturday 2nd March at 10am which will last for two hours. It's a chance to shake off any nerves and suss out the competition!
