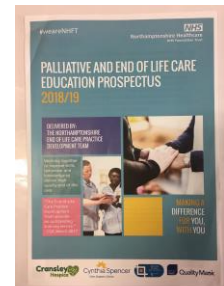
Welcome to our March newsletter, as usual our education sessions are detailed below; please note information on how to book is at the bottom of the newsletter.
