Dr Kathryn Mannix, retired Consultant in Palliative Care, recently offered some words of wisdom regarding Terminal Agitation that can be summarised as:

'There are so many causes of agitation, but often the same solutions:

- Calm, quiet, smiling care from familiar people.
- Check for missed medications.
- Check for discomfort.

Only use sedatives if the person is distressed- many muddled people aren't distressed, even though their loved ones are disconcerted by the changes in them.'

Evidence Based Care in the Last Days of life for Support Workers

This interactive workshop offers evidence based education & simulated learning for support workers across health & social care providers. It focuses on the key recommendations for care in the last days of life raised in National and local policy and guidance. Topics include communication, advance care planning, symptom management, the role of the support worker and the practical elements of caring for a person in the last days of life.

'Care towards the end of life'

A short course for Newly Registered Nurses

This short course will be partly depicted by the learning needs of the participants, but will include increasing foundation knowledge regarding:



- Prognostication proactive identification of people coming towards the end of their life
- Advance care planning principles of ACP, national policy and legislation, how to implement and associated communication skills
- **Symptom management** assessment, management of key symptoms in last days, anticipatory prescribing, and communication regarding symptoms
- **Priorities for care of the dying person** considering the national 5 priorities for care of the dying person and the application to practice
- End of life care services available across Northamptonshire
- Resilience caring for one's self

Workshop 1 will be Face 2 Face from 9am – 4.30pm. Workshops 2 - 6 will be held 1-4pm via MS Teams, dates are:

Care of dying adults in the last days of life for Registered Healthcare **Professionals**

These workshops offer an opportunity to consider evidence-based End of Life Care; Learners will be registered healthcare professionals from across health and social care providers. Four, two hour workshops will focus on the following key theme including; prognostication, haematological picture in the deteriorating patient, advance care planning, symptom assessment and management, decision making regarding clinically assisted hydration and nutrition and exploring grief and bereavement.
